

JFK student charged in Tuesday's threat

CHEEKTOWAGA – The Cheektowaga Police Department announced that a 14-year-old student has been arrested and charged with Falsely Reporting an Incident.

“The threat yesterday created a major inconvenience and concern for students, staff, and parents,” Assistant Chief of Police Jim Speyer said in a news release. “Many JFK students missed the school day or were picked up early by worried parents.”

The teen surrendered herself at police headquarters Wednesday morning. Because she is under 16-year-old, her case will be handed in Family Court.

Falsely Reporting an Incident is a Class A Misdemeanor.
