Cheektowaga police looking for information on vehicle after shots were fired at Galleria

CHEEKTOWAGA, N.Y. (WIVB) - Cheektowaga police have released a photo of a Honda Pilot they think a shooter jumped into after firing shots at the Walden Galleria this past Mother's Day.

They are looking for help identifying the vehicle and the shooter.

Assistant Chief Jim Speyer says investigators found eight shell casings in a mall parking lot near Macy's on May 13th.

"Thank God nobody was injured," he said.

Speyer says after the shots were fired, the perpetrator jumped into the Honda Pilot, which then took off. It is believed to be a 2006 or 2007 model.

"The challenges are that this happened so quickly," Speyer said. "Even one of our officers who was in the parking lot at another location within the mall premises got to the scene right away, and everything was over with by the time he got there. It happened very quickly. Both vehicles fled the scene.:
