Local "Click it or Ticket" checkpoint yields 90 summonses

CHEEKTOWAGA – A "Click it or Ticket" joint traffic checkpoint held by the State Police and Cheektowaga Police on May 31st netted over 90 traffic summonses according to town police.

The checkpoint was set up on Galleria Drive from 3 pm – 7 pm. Cheektowaga Police logged 59 total summonses for vehicle and traffic violations; 14 were seatbelt related. State Police recorded 34 total summonses for V&T violations; 9 were for seatbelts.

The statewide campaign ran from May 21 to June 3 as part of a national enforcement effort to encourage motorists, passengers, and children to take the important step of wearing their seat belts every time they are on the roadway.
