

Cheektowaga Police Blotter: Thursday, September 27, 2018

First responders were called to 196 incidents on Thursday. Here are just a few of the calls that came out across Town.

12:33 am – Police checked on a man “slumped over the wheel” in a running vehicle in the parking lot of McDonald’s on Clinton Street. It turned out he was just sleeping.

1:28 am – A domestic incident report was filed after someone was threatening to blow up a house. There was a stay away order already in effect.

3:24 am – An officer on patrol noticed some suspicious people hanging around tour buses in the Millennium Hotel parking lot. It was Kid Rock’s band hanging around. Everything was in order.

4:36 am – Someone called police to say they spotted a man exposing themselves, masturbating, and filming it while on the Genesee Street bridge over the I-90. The caller was someone passing by the scene. Police picked up a drunk man and took him home. He was fully clothed when officers arrived at the scene.



6:40 am – More than a dozen car break-ins were reported around the areas of Lemoine, Montfort, Bert, and Cleveland Drive. Some police reports were filed and a checkpoint in the area was requested by neighbors.

7:06 am – There was a request from the county highway department to get cars moved off of Beach Road so that milling work could be done.

9:24 am – A police report was filed after a person found a golf bag filled with golf disks he left behind in a parking lot on accident listed on Craigslist.

12:56 pm – A person was taken to ECMC with a partial finger amputation from the Erie County Water Authority on Union Road. This is after they got their finger caught on a tailgate chain. A police report was filed on the industrial accident.

2:37 pm – The dog control officer picked up six guinea pigs that were abandoned in a box in a field off of Lackawanna Avenue. They were possibly there for several days. They were taken to the SPCA.

3:34 pm – A 6-year-old was taken to Children’s Hospital by ambulance with a compound arm fracture after falling off the monkey bars at the Maryvale Elementary playground.

4:10 pm – U-Crest firefighters were called to a stove fire on Northcrest Avenue. It turned out to be a defective stove. The gas was shut off and the resident was advised not to use it until they spoke with the landlord.

4:21 pm – A Grayhound Bus contacted police dispatch saying they wanted a passenger removed from a bus on Pine Ridge because he was being unruly. The man was kicked off the bus and taken to the bus station by police.

5:39 pm – A police report was filed after a man stole baby formula from Tops in Thruway Plaza. He ran from the area – breaking a woman’s fence off of Harlem Road. Police were unable to locate the man.

6:24 pm – Two neighbors on Beach Road were strongly advised not to speak to each other. One of the neighbors was told she would be arrested if she continued to harass and trespass on the other neighbor’s property.

7:07 pm – A caller on Broadway found a piece of roast in her backyard and thought someone was trying to poison her dogs. A police report was filed.
