

Stabbing victim seeks treatment at St. Joseph's Hospital

CHEEKTOWAGA – The victim of a stabbing sought emergency treatment from doctors at Sisters of Charity Hospital, St. Joseph Campus Monday night according to Cheektowaga Police.

Hospital security called Cheektowaga Police around 9:04 pm after a 54-year-old man walked into the emergency department and collapsed in the lobby. Assistant Chief of Police Jim Speyer tells Cheektowaga Chronicle the man had a stab wound to the chest.

The man told Cheektowaga Police that the incident occurred in the City of Buffalo. Mr. Speyer says the victim was not specific and he was uncooperative with Cheektowaga detectives.

Hospital video shows that a vehicle dropped the man off at the emergency department before driving away.

The man was later transported to Erie County Medical Center around 50 minutes later.

The investigation was turned over to Buffalo Police.
