Aggressive dog hearing adjourned

CHEEKTOWAGA, NY (WIVB) - Residents of a south Cheektowaga neighborhood intend to sound off about dogs they feel are dangerous. They will also speak on the town's alleged lack of response over the past several years.

Originally, a hearing was scheduled for Monday morning, but it was adjourned.

Last week, we reported on a family puggle who was mauled to death by four large dogs that broke down a fence separating the two yards on Castlewood and Borden.

The property at 808 Borden has five dogs altogether that neighbors have filed complaints about since 2015.

The Cheektowaga Police Department confirms the attack happened last weekend.

An aggressive dog hearing will take place on Monday morning at 9:30 at the Town Hall.
