Police: Man beaten 30 times in (rage incident

A Cheektowaga man is in the hospital tonight following a road rage incident that left needing surgery.

Cheektowaga Police say it was shortly after 2:45 Wednesday afternoon when 41-year Matthew Rudy was driving on Walden Ave. near Chick-fil-A. Police say he was cut of man in the left lane and the man then slammed on his breaks, got out of the car and punched Rudy in the face through the window. Police say he then dragged Rudy out car, in the middle of the median and brutally beat him 20-30 times.

The man took off. Police are now searching for him, and asking anyone who witnesse attack to come forward.

Rudy was transported to ECMC. He had to have surgery on his eye, and his wife says there's a possibility he may be blind.


