

# Union East student was approached by a stranger on Eggert Road

CHEEKTOWAGA – The Cheektowaga Police Department is warning the public after a recent stranger danger encounter in the north part of town Thursday.

A young girl was waiting for her school bus on Eggert Road around 8:30 am when she approached by a gray, 4-door sedan type vehicle operated by a black man around 50-years-old.

“The male had black hair and dark complexion. The unknown male stopped the vehicle and lowered the passenger side window and asked the youth if she wanted some candy. The vehicle then drove past the 4th grader but returned shortly after and drove by the female several more times prior to leaving the area,” Assistant Chief of Police Michael Sliwinski said.

The child was picked up by her bus and taken to Union East Elementary where she alerted school administrators.
