

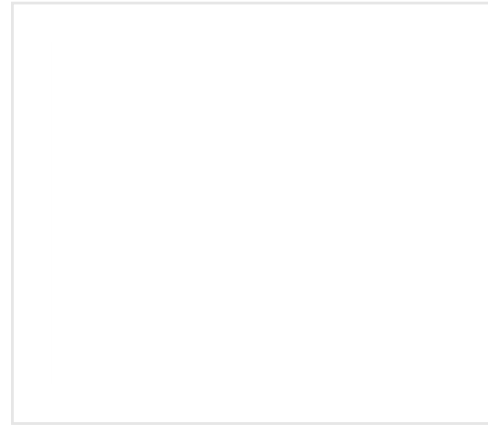
Police say two men involved in fight at hotel on Transit road

Two men taken to hospital after fight at Lancaster hotel

Lancaster Police say both were taken to ECMC. One has been treated and released, and the other is still at the hospital.

LANCASTER, N.Y. — Lancaster Police are seeking help after two men got into an argument at the Hospitality Inn on Transit Road on Sunday night.

Police had responded to a fight in progress call at 8:18 p.m. Sunday. Two men were injured and taken to Erie County Medical Center. One has been treated and released, and the other is still at the hospital.



Lancaster Police said the men had been taken from the scene by 9 p.m.

Officials did not reveal the nature of the injuries, or the men's names or ages. They did say both men were in town on business and not from the area.

With the large crowd at the site, Lancaster Police received help from the Amherst, Depew and Cheektowaga police departments, as well as the New York State Police.

Two Buffalo firefighters taken to hospital following west side house fire

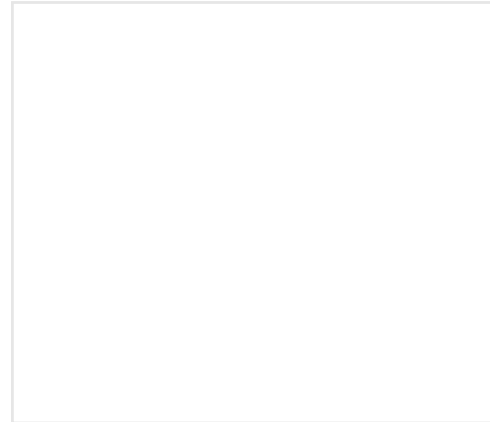
The fire broke out in home on Gelston Street late Sunday night.

BUFFALO, N.Y. — Two firefighters were taken to the hospital following a house fire on Buffalo's west side.

A two-alarm fire broke out in a home on Gelston Street just before 11 p.m. Sunday and quickly spread to the house next door.

The injured first responders were taken to ECMC and are expected to be okay.

Fire officials tell us that both homes appeared to be vacant, though uncertainty can be dangerous.



"When we get to a fire—even if it's boarded up and it looks totally vacant—we don't call it vacant until one of our trucks search it, which can put them in a little danger," says Buffalo Fire Department Division Chief, Pete Kertzie.
